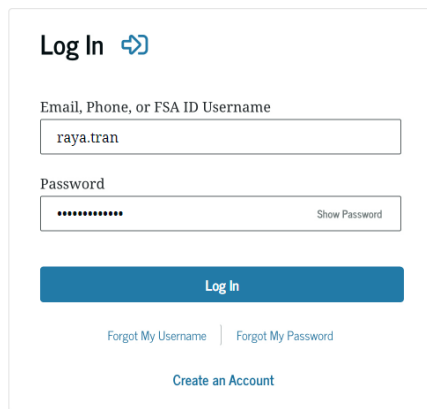


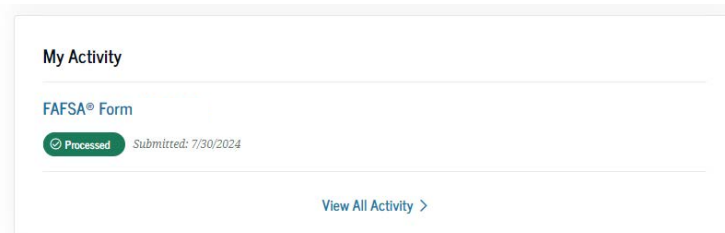

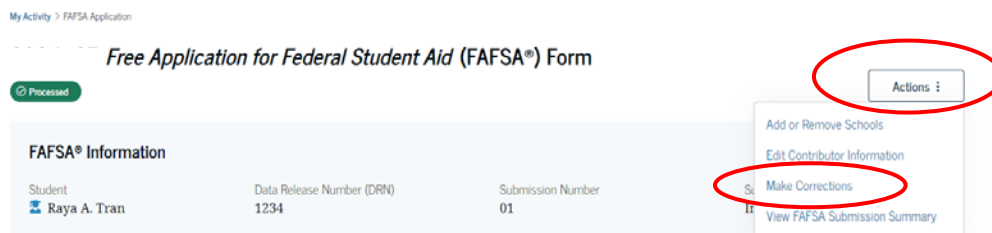
1. **Log in** to [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) using your FSA ID (user name and password)



2. **Navigate** to the **Status Center Dashboard**
3. Under **My Activity**, select your processed FAFSA submission, this will bring you to the Status Center Details screen.



4. You are starting a voluntary correction, select the **Action button**, and start a correction by selecting **Make a Correction**.





5. You want to correct your high school status in the demographics section.
